ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984 SECTION 14 (1)
TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF THROUGH TRAFFIC
Hagg Bridge, Hagg Lane, Storwood

Notice is hereby given that The East Riding of Yorkshire Council intends not less than seven days from the date of this notice to make an Order, the effect of which will be to prohibit any vehicle from proceeding over Hagg Bridge, Hagg Lane, Storwood commencing 27th April 2020.

The road closure is necessary to enable improvement works, including the upgrade of parapets and carriageway including the installation of permanent traffic lights to be carried out in a manner consistent with ensuring the safety of the public. The Order is valid for 18 months, but it is anticipated that the works will be completed within 5 months.

The alternative route for traffic affected by the road closure will be via:

Common Lane, Main Street, Sandhill Lane, The Street, Sutton Lane, York Road, Hodson Lane Roundabout, Hodson Lane, Melbourne Road, Road From Hagg Lane To General Lane, Hagg Lane.

The diversion route will be signed at the time of closure. The road will be closed to all through traffic but access will be maintained for pedestrians.
