WEBMASTER

No Cold Calling in Main Street and Sutton Lane – due to 100% success of parishioners agreeing that Main Street and Sutton Lane should become a "No Cold Calling Zone", ERYC has approved the request and signs will be erected in the near future. The Parish Council are now looking into other areas of the village joining. The clerk has received interest from one street in the village, if any other areas are interested, please get in touch.

Tree Works – six trees have been pruned in Main Street, from the Post Office and up to Burton Holme Farm.

Grass verges – Please do not park on the village green or highway verges, we have such a pretty village, do keep it neat and tidy.

Play Park, Main Street – the PC has been successful in their endeavours for a WREN grant towards new play equipment at the Play Park. A date is now being arranged for when the equipment can be installed, so expect the park to be closed for approximately one week during October. The old Tarzan trail will be removed and the new equipment with safety surfacing in its place.
