Parish Update

Community Speed Watch – Wayne Goodwin the Community Speed Watch Co-Ordinator, organised a training event for the volunteers who will be carrying out the speed checks in Main Street and Sutton Lane. Hopefully we might see a reduction in the speeding traffic travelling through Barmby Moor. Thank you to the Parishioners who have volunteered.

Village Seats and bench – the Parish Council has purchased two village seats and one bench which you will be sited at Back Lane, Keldspring Lane junction and Beck Side near the wild life area.

Willow Trees at Beck Side – Northern Powergrid (Amey Contractors) have changed the willow tree pruning date at Beck Side to the 17 August 2020. The time has been changed to allow the wild life area to be protected during the spring growing season. The electricity will be cut off that morning, but nearby residents will be notified nearer the time.

New lighting column in Main Street – the street light outside The Rowans in Main Street has been replaced.

Bus Lay-by A1079 outside Barmby Moor House/Constantine House –The Parish Council has erected a new bus shelter on the A1079 for people travelling towards Hull.

Bus Shelters in Main Street – the three wood bus shelters in Main Street have been fitted with cork notice boards inside. Please use to advertise local events.

Neighbourhood Development Plan – the Steering Group members have recently agreed on the final document to be submitted to the East Riding of Yorkshire Council. It is now being submitted to ERYC in its route towards adoption. This can take some time as there are several stages to complete. A copy of the latest draft Plan can be seen on the Parish Council's website. Please have a look.

Parish Precept 2020/2021– this year's precept for Barmby Moor is £24,239. This precept will mean that the band D billing amount attributable to this parish council will be £55.09, which is an increase of £4.02 and 7.9% compared to 2019/2020.

Parking outside the school during pick-up and drop-off times – the Parish Council has approached ERYC asking if a barrier can be erected outside the school gate. It has been noticed children are running out of the entrance straight onto the road.

Emergency Plan – is in the process of being updated by the PC.
